JMU Libraries

- Liaison librarians provide expertise in your subject area
- JMU's institutional repository can increase dissemination of your research
- Data management best practices

Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP)

- Pre-Award basic functions:
 - Distributes information concerning potential funding opportunities
 - Reviews agency guidelines and assists with the overall proposal submission process (including budget development)
 - Negotiates sponsor agreements, relationships and award terms and conditions
 - Interprets and enforces the regulatory, contractual, and administrative requirements



Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP)

- Post-Award basic functions:
 - Issues Department IDs for sponsored projects, notifies the appropriate university offices with an award announcement, and provides award materials to the principal investigator.
 - Assist with the financial management of the award and invoices as required according to the sponsored agreement.
 - Manages effort reporting.
 - Facilitates sponsor prior approval requests including budget revisions, no-cost extensions, etc.
 - Completes all finance reporting and closeout documents (property reports, patent & invention reports, release of claims, etc.)



Strategic Research Support

- Position created in April 2020 to:
 - assist faculty and collaborative teams in developing grant proposals of the highest quality, with a focus on public funding;
 - work with the Vice Provost and academic leaders to define a strategic approach to matching JMU's competitive strengths with funding opportunities; and
 - produce and deliver professional development opportunities for faculty to sharpen their grant-seeking skills, in collaboration with CFI as appropriate.



Office of Research Integrity

- Promotes a culture of compliance, research integrity, and high quality research within the University community.
- Responsible for:
 - Monitoring regulatory changes
 - Recommending institutional responses to ensure compliance
 - Overseeing the development and implementation of policies, procedures, programs and educational activities which satisfy federal, state and institutional regulations governing research ethics and the responsible conduct of research



Office of Research Integrity

- Programs that we oversee:
 - Institutional Review Board (IRB – Human subjects research)
 - Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC – Animal subjects research)
 - Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC – Recombinant DNA and biohazardous materials research)
 - Research Ethics and Financial Conflict of Interest
 - Export Controls (as related to research)
 - Lab Safety (in collaboration with Risk Management)



Technology Innovation & Economic Development

Our mission is to promote innovation, enhance research by connecting inventors and the business community, and foster economic development through protecting and commercializing intellectual property.

- Our services to innovators include:
 - Education on JMU's Intellectual Policy #1107, IP protection and process
 - Prior art search and competitor analysis
 - Patent application filing
 - Connections to business functions such as market analysis, business plan development, and early stage capital investment



A startup company DermBiont, Inc. was founded in 2017, based on a patent granted in 2013, by Dr. Reid Harris, Biology (pictured) and Kevin Minbiole, formerly JMU Chemistry. They filed an IP disclosure in 2009 for Skin Probiotics based on salamander skin research.
