

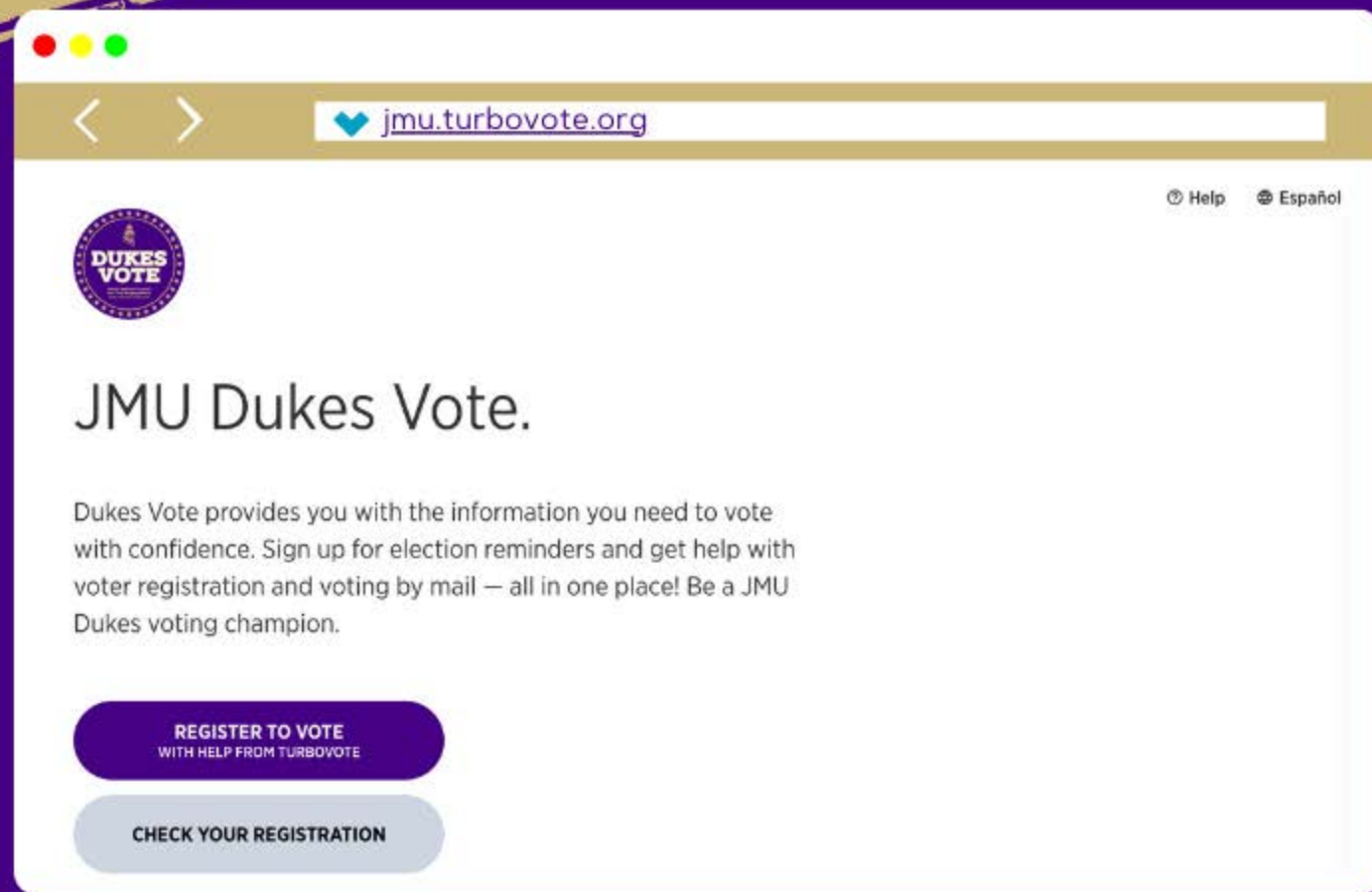
# Voter Registration with TurboVote

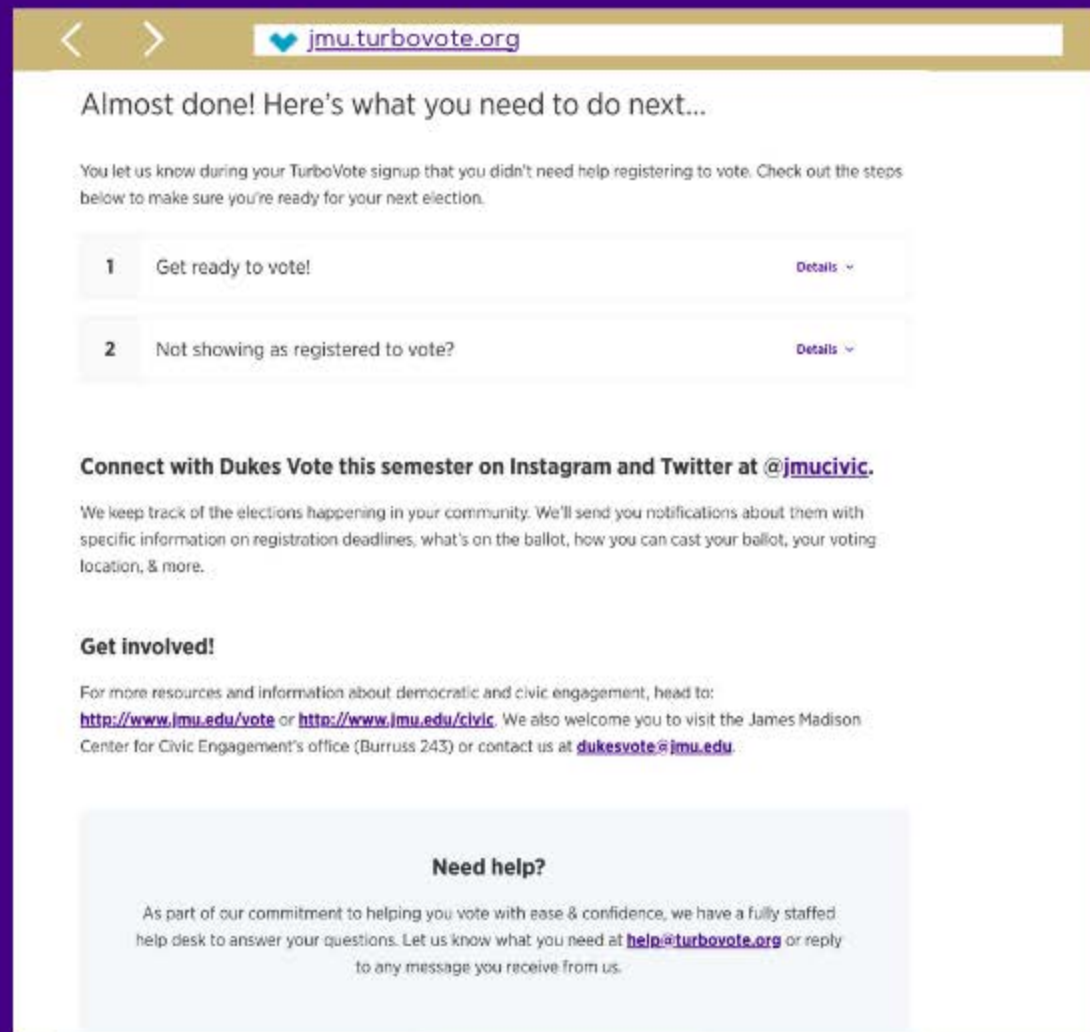
