University Recreation (UREC)

JMU's award-winning <u>recreation facility</u> provides free access to indoor and outdoor recreation spaces around campus for all faculty and staff. Spouses of JMU employees may <u>apply for Spouse URAC</u> (University Recreation Access Cards) to access UREC's facilities with or without the company of their JMU-employed spouse. Immediate family members may accompany faculty and staff free of charge during family hours on weekends and during spring, summer, and winter breaks!
