Getting Along with Coworkers

Attitude

- Decide to get along no matter what (respect)
- Get to know other people right away
- Keep things positive (topics, comments, ideas)
- Anticipate organizational stress and be flexible
- Value others' time (share briefly & professionally)

Discuss:

• Identify which words & behaviors show respect

Perspective

- Are you "questioning"
 - Someone's status
 - Someone's certainty (opinion)
 - Someone's autonomy
 - Someone's relatedness
 - Someone's fairness
- When you "question," a person may feel threatened
- Assure and reassure others of your appreciation for them and their viewpoint(s)

Discuss:

• Talk about ways to reassure others

Engagement

- Be yourself, and allow others freedom to do so
- Find common ground (work or otherwise)
- Pause before you speak
- Give information and time freely to genuinely help
- Check in with others regularly (make time for talk that isn't about tasks)

Discuss:

• Share how you remember to pause



Closing – Getting Along

Focus on (your own) behaviors & goals
